



# PITCH ALLOCATION NOTICE

22<sup>nd</sup> January 2018

With the completion of the new AGP nearing, the committee have reviewed the pitch allocation for the remainder of the 2017/18 season, and the 2018/19 season (**age groups below are based on your 2018/19 ages**).

The pitch allocation for the AGP will be as below.

18:30-20:00	½ Pitch	Ladies & Girls
19:35-20:05	½ Pitch	Under 18s & Seniors
20:05-21:00	Full Pitch	Under 18s & Seniors
Wednesday Night		
18:30-19:30	2/3 Pitch	Under 11s, 12s & 13s
18:30-19:30	1/3 Pitch	Under 14s
19:35-21:00	Full Pitch	Under 15s, 16s & 17s

Where age groups share allocation it is up to the head coaches of those age groups to determine their shared usage fairly. Age groups may decide on a rotation (2 of 3 age groups take ½ pitch each on a rotation e.g.: week 1 U15 & U16, week 2 U15 & U17, week 3 U16 & U17 – team not on AGP will get ½ grass pitch).

If weather does not permit training on grass pitches then all age groups will have a right to train on the AGP at their allotted time (e.g, U15s, U16s & U17s would have use of 1/3 pitch each from 19:35-21:00 on Wednesday) – taking precedence over any agreed rotation. If grass pitches return to use in the following week, then the rotation will continue as previously (e.g. if the grass is unplayable in week 2, but returns to play in week 3 it will be U16 & U17 to train on the AGP).

The CRFC management committee will decide and communicate weeks that the grass (and/or AGP) should not be used due to inclement weather.

On Tuesday and Wednesday night training, please limit usage of the changing rooms to changing rooms 1 & 2 only wherever possible.

All teams using the AGP must finish their session at the allotted time, and have exited the pitch within 5 minutes. Our time on the pitch is limited so it is very important that all head coaches ensure that these times are kept to.



## Rules for AGP Usage

It is up to the head coach of the age group to ensure that all footwear (including that of coaches and any helpers/spectators on the pitch) conform with the below – without exception. If the committee finds that this or any other rule is not being monitored closely by any age group they will review the age groups further usage of the AGP.

### YES

Rugby Boots with moulded or metal screw in stud



### NO

Flat sole shoes / trainers, Blades, Spikes, Astros, muddy footwear



**Dogs are absolutely not allowed on the AGP.**
